Dear Attorney General Bondi,

The Trump Administration's courage in confronting bad practices, bad actors, and bad policy has reshaped many parts of our government with long-overdue change. At the Department of Justice (DOJ), your team's tackling of the weaponization of law and investigating fraud has been widely reported. But the DOJ has completely neglected to enforce a law that would impact a growing Constitutional crisis, impacting the stability of the country.

Students for Life asks you to enforce the Comstock Act, which says that abortifacients may not be mailed and to investigate violations of that law. Abused women, now too often drugged without their knowledge or consent, deserve justice, and preborn babies deserve better than a targeted campaign to end their lives, launched by abortion pill profiteers and pro-abortion politicians who are looking to make a name for themselves.

We will not be able to remain the United States of America if "Blue States" continue to openly violate and undermine the laws of "Red States" for the purpose of causing more death by abortion. This would not be permitted in other areas of law, whether contract law, estate or child support matters, or any other interstate arrangements. The Trump Administration, which talks often about respect for the rule of law, must enforce our laws to preserve state sovereignty, civil order, and the lives of preborn babies and their mothers.

Abortion-loving governors and legislators should not be free to pick and choose which laws they like. The Trump Administration does not turn a blind eye to violations of election or immigration law or to fraud in government programs. This must be no different.

If the DOJ ignores the blatant attacks on pro-life states, it is a dereliction of duty. We ask that the team in place acts today to end the trafficking in Chemical Abortion Pills by national and international pill pushers who mock state laws to profit from death-by-abortion.

As matter of public safety, enforcing the Comstock Act also addresses the reality of sex trafficking and abusive partners getting Chemical Abortion Pills anonymously and then using the deadly drugs on mothers without their knowledge or consent. Allowing online, no-test abortion allows that horror to continue.

Another risk of neglecting enforcement is the reality of abortion water pollution. Using the abortion industry's own math, each year, more than 50 tons of chemically tainted blood and placenta tissue, along with human remains, go into America's waterways, with active metabolites that continue to have an impact.

Members of Congress, including then Sen. Marco Rubio, have signed onto letters, with concern for the impact of this reckless distribution of these progesterone blocking drugs. This negligent policy risks the crystal-clear water President Trump extolled on the campaign trail and allows for endocrine disruptors to be in our waterways, putting human, animal, plant, and aquatic life, including endangered species, at jeopardy.

During the [Biden Administration's](#) abuse of power in the name of COVID response, they decided [in 2022 that Chemical Abortion Pills could be mailed](#), claiming they didn't know how Chemical Abortion Pills might be used by those receiving them in the mail.

Writing for the Office of Legal Policy, [Christopher H. Schroeder penned](#): "We conclude that section 1461 does not prohibit the mailing, or the delivery or receipt by mail, of mifepristone or misoprostol where the sender lacks the intent that the recipient of the drugs will use them unlawfully."

The media barrage from pro-abortion "Blue States" to pro-life "Red States" makes it clear that the intent IS to use them, even unlawfully, depending on the jurisdiction.

[California Gov. Gavin Newsom's profane response](#) to Louisiana Attorney General Liz Murrill, when she tried to extradite an alleged drug dealer from his state, shows their intent. "Louisiana plans to sue me because I won't extradite a doctor for providing an abortion," Newsom wrote on X. Directly addressing Murrill, he added: "Go f--- yourself. California will never help you criminalize healthcare."

Healthcare is a much-abused word by abortion lovers. Chemical Abortion Pills expose women to injury, infertility, and death, and at rates higher than the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) first admitted. Online pill pushers are not following up to ensure that the death intended did not also extend to a mother, despite the fact that death is supposed to be reported. It's all "don't ask, don't tell" when it comes to Chemical Abortion Pills.

Attorney General Bondi, we ask you to enforce the Comstock Act immediately and investigate violators of the prohibition to mail Chemical Abortion Pills, both in the U.S. and internationally.

As the [District Attorney for Louisiana's 18<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Tony Clayton](#) has noted, "Shipping an abortion pill from another state is equivalent to me of shipping fentanyl or any other type drug over here that ends up in the mouths and stomachs of our minor kids."

Enforcing the Comstock Act is the right thing to do for preborn babies, for mothers, and for the environment. It shows respect for the law and the states. The failure to do so makes all the wrong people happy — pill pushers and abusers — and we believe better of the Trump Administration. Please prioritize this vital effort today.

In addition, we also ask that the Trump Administration's commitment to ending fraud in healthcare spending be extended to abortion industry mega vendors who use healthcare dollars to prop up a business of abortion and sterilizing, wrong-sex hormone distribution. The DOJ should add its investigatory expertise to investigating Planned Parenthood, as they should be classified as an unqualified government vendor, in light of an investigation underway at the Small Business Administration. Support for attacking the fraud in Medicaid is reflected in numerous letters by Members of Congress and pro-family/pro-life organizations.
